10 Easy Ways YOU Can Help Animals:

- 1 Ask your teacher for humane alternatives and say "NO" to animal dissection.
- 2 Call or e-mail us for information on the latest dissection alternatives.
- 3 Look for the Leaping Bunny Logo and purchase only cruelty free products. Visit www.leapingbunny.org.
- 4 Don't buy products made with real fur, lanolin, leather, musk oil, silk, suede, etc.
- 5 Ask your school to provide vegan or vegetarian food choices.
- 6 Monitor science fairs for inhumane use of living animals.
- 7 Don't support school events that exploit animals such as animal circuses, rodeos, donkey basketball, etc.
- 8 Pick colleges or universities committed to cruelty free science education.

- 10 And, always follow the golden rule:
Be kind to animals and people!
